Study abroad in Brazil this Winter Break and earn up to 6 academic credits from ESPM, the #1 ranked marketing and communications school in Brazil. During this program, students will travel across this beautiful country visiting Rio de Janeiro, Sao Paulo, and the colonial sea-side village of Paraty. Students will take stimulating courses with excellent professors and will have the opportunity to learn about Brazil through **professional visits** to leading Brazilian companies and organizations.

Throughout a month of classes and visits, students will gain a broad overview of Brazilian culture, economy, society, business, and politics with a focus on opportunities presented by the World Cup and Olympics.



TRAVELING ITINERARY:

The Winter program in Brazil will begin in **Sao Paulo**, the financial and cultural hot-spot at the heart of the Brazilian economy. Then, our group will travel together to **Paraty**, a colonial gem on the coast between Sao Paulo and Rio, where we will spend New Year's Eve. Then on the 4th of January, our group will travel together to Rio de Janeiro, and will have classes on campus of ESPM, the #1 ranked marketing and communications school in Brazil.



Rio de Janeiro



Rio de Janeiro is beautiful. Stunning. The mix of water and mountains in the background is unique and unforgettable. But, it's the culture of the city that will have you crying out for more! Cariocas (residents of Rio) refer proudly to their city as the "Cidade Maravilhosa" (Marvelous City). As you get to know it, you will soon discover that they are not exaggerating. World-class attractions such listed for UNESCO World Heritage recognition, as the Pao de Acucar, the statue of Christ the Redeemer atop lush Corcovado, and the beaches such as Ipanema and Copacabana.

Paraty (Green Coast)



A town of about 30,000 on Brazil's Coasta Verde ("green coast"), Paraty sits about halfway between Rio de Janeiro and Sao Paulo. The 17th century city fell into decline but was rediscovered by artists and creative entrepreneurs about a decade ago. Since then, it's become a leader in sustainable tourism development, and has been shortnot just for its beautiful historical Portuguese colonial architecture, but also because of its extreme natural beauty of white sand beaches

Sao Paulo



In order to really understand Brazil (and all that it has to offer), students and travelers should get to know this city! Sao Paulo's nightlife is considered one of the best in the world. The city is full of restaurants from all over the world, live music bars, clubs, worldclass museums, cultural centers, theaters, concert halls, and cinemas. The shopping in the city is among the most diverse and sophisticated in the world.



COURSES:

 Our courses are designed to offer students a deep insight in to the Brazilian economy, society, political situation and culture. Classes are taught on-campus (and while **traveling**) by a faculty of multinational and cosmopolitan professors, and will be finely woven into the city of Rio de Janeiro, making the most of its landmarks and event spaces. Depending on the session, students may take up to TWO three-credit courses for a maximum of 6 credits.
